





Book Readers Supper Club

Complications, a National Book Award Finalist, by Atul Gawande, explores the nature of the medical profession itself, in terms of an art more than a science. Gawande divides the book into three sections, examining doctors' fallibility, baffling medical cases and uncertainty in medicine. The chapters on fallibility look at



medical training, mistakes in care and the complexity of bad doctors. The baffling medical cases chapters show that medical science doesn't have the answers to all conditions that may seem on the surface to be diagnosable. Finally, Gawande examines the process of dealing with what is unknowable in medicine, despite all the knowledge medical professionals have at their disposal.



Viet Thanh Nguyen
Award Winner

With the pace and suspense of a thriller, and prose that has been compared to Graham Greene and Saul Bellow, *The Sympathizer* is a sweeping epic of love and betrayal. The narrator, a communist double agent, is a "man of two minds." He is a half-French, half-Vietnamese army captain who arranges



to come to America after the Fall of Saigon.
