With flair and finesse, the chefs at Tokyo Samurai in Bartonville serve up delicious Japanese cuisine. As soon as you walk through the door, you're greeted by the delightful aroma of Asian spices. The seating is vast and can accommodate large groups around the hibachi grill. And if you're in a hurry, it's perfect for a quick lunch as well. There are separate tables for ordering sushi and specials like vegetable tempura, udon noodles and bento boxes.

The sushi is incredible! Every roll is handmade with fresh seafood by master sushi chefs. They feature favorites like the Spicy Tuna Roll, Philadelphia Roll and Spider Roll. But they also have delicious specialty rolls, like the Paradise Roll, with tempura shrimp, cream cheese, avocado and spicy crab, or the Dragon Roll, with tempura shrimp and cucumber then topped with avocado.

If you want an interactive dining experience, go for the hibachi. The chefs cook your meal with a performance filled with flashing knives, flipping food and tons of fun. 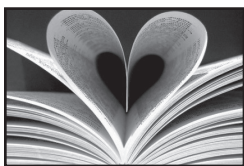

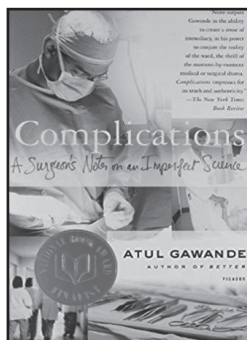

Book Readers Supper Club

Complications, a National Book Award Finalist, by Atul Gawande, explores the nature of the medical profession itself, in terms of an art more than a science. Gawande divides the book into three sections, examining doctors' fallibility, baffling medical cases and uncertainty in medicine. The chapters on fallibility look at medical training, mistakes in care and the complexity of bad doctors. The baffling medical cases chapters show that medical science doesn't have the answers to all conditions that may seem on the surface to be diagnosable. Finally, Gawande examines the process of dealing with what is unknowable in medicine, despite all the knowledge medical professionals have at their disposal.

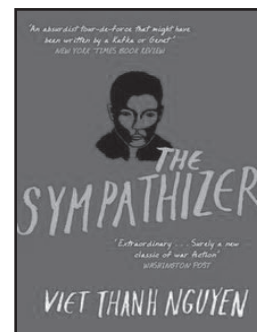
