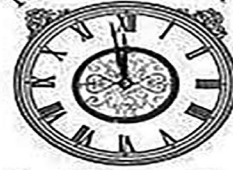

- Includes practices, meets, end-of-the-year party, t-shirt and medal

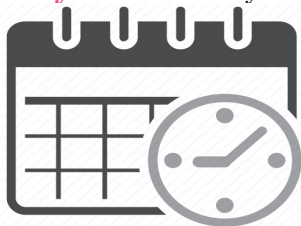

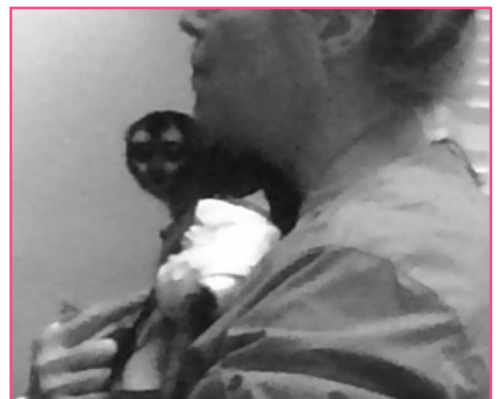

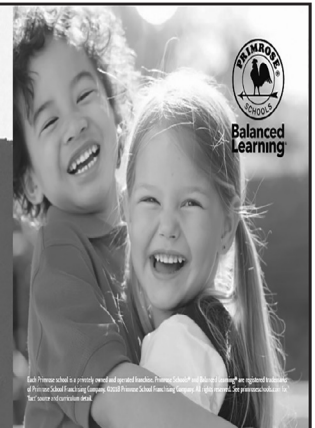

Summer is right around the corner. And when temperatures soar, you need to take extra steps to protect your pet from the heat. Here are the top tips to keep your canine cool and comfortable.

Tips to Keep your Dog Cool



1. Add ice cubes to your four-legged family member's water dish.



2. Make sure your dog has plenty of shade.



3. Put a small child's pool outside with shallow water so your dog can cool down.



4. Be sure to bring a collapsible water dish on all walks.



5. Avoid walking on hot pavement. If it's too hot for your hand, it's too hot for their paws.



6. Take walks in the early morning or late evening to avoid the hottest part of the day.



7. Give your furry friend a frozen treat.



8. Check the humidity. When it's high, your dog has a harder time of cooling himself.



9. Make sure your dog is groomed properly. Frequent brushing keeps your pet's coat healthy and comfortable.



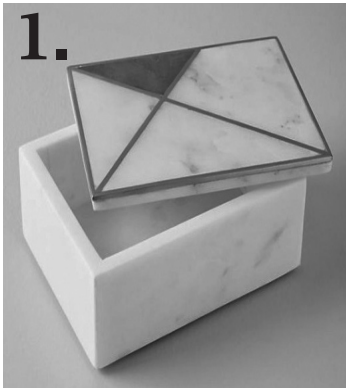
10. Watch for signs of overheating: Heavy panting, heavy drooling, rapid heartrate, dark red gums, dizziness and weakness.



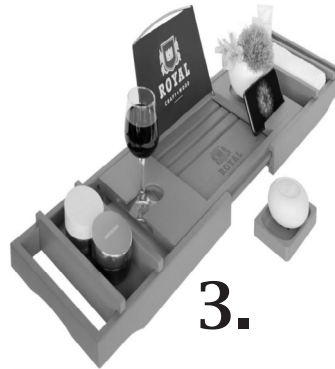
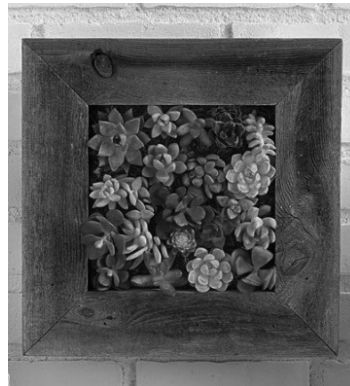
