

HIGHLAND SHORES POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

(REVISED 2023)

NO LIFEGUARDS/POOL MONITORS ON DUTY. MEMBERS & GUESTS SWIM AT THEIR OWN RISK. IN CASE OF EMERGENCY CALL 911 OR USE EMERGENCY PHONE OUTSIDE POOL GATE.

A Highland Shores Key Fob is required to enter the pool. Climbing over the fence or gate is prohibited. Trespassers will be prosecuted. Key Fobs are issued by the on-site management office (limited to **two (2)** key fobs per residence). The cost for replacement key fobs will be established by the Homeowners Association.

The use of the pool is for residents of Highland Shores only and their permitted guests. Each household may not have more than **six (6)** guests at the community pool at any one time. Homeowners and renters are responsible for their household member and guests.

A person, age 16 or above must accompany children under **fourteen (14)** years of age.

Keep the gate completely closed at all times. DO NOT open the gate for anyone. A shower should be taken before entering the pools.

Handling, jumping or hanging on lane ropes is prohibited. Lap lanes are for lap swimming only.

No water guns or water balloons are allowed in the pool area at any time. No **regulation** balls of any kind (footballs, basketballs, soccer balls, baseballs, etc.) are allowed in the pool area at any time. Rough housing or horse play which poses a danger to others is not allowed. Use of floatation devices, rafts or toys must not interfere with other swimmers use of the pool.

Proper swimwear is required. No jeans, cutoffs, street clothes, or loose clothing allowed for safety reasons. Babies/toddlers must wear swim diapers. Changing diapers within 6' of the pool is prohibited.

Persons with skin abrasions, blisters, cuts, inflamed eyes, ear infections, diarrhea or communicable diseases are not allowed to use the swimming pool facilities.

No glass containers of any kind are allowed in the pool area and no gum is allowed. No bikes, skateboards, roller blades, scooters, or motorized vehicles are allowed inside the pool area.

NO DIVING permitted at any time. No running, jumping or skipping is allowed in the pool area. Extended breath holding activities are dangerous and prohibited. Pool area may be slippery when wet.

NO pets are permitted in the pool area. Registered service animals are restricted from the pool. NO profanity or loud music.

NO SMOKING INSIDE THE POOL AREA OR WITHIN 15 FT. OF ANY POOL ENTRY GATE (INCLUDING PIPES, CIGARS, CIGARETTES, VAPOR, E-CIGARETTES, ETC.,).

Leave pool area clean at all times. Any items you bring in must leave with you. Homeowners Association or Management is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged items while using the pool facilities

Keep the safety equipment in place. Life rings and shepherd crook/hook may not be used as toys or floats at any time. Emergency equipment is for emergencies only.

In the event of lightning or thunder, all swimmers will clear the pool and remain away from the water for a minimum of thirty (30) minutes after the lightning or thunder has ceased.
