



Pet Corner

Keeping your Pet Snug in a Storm

Intense flashes of light. Loud crashes of thunder. Severe weather can be scary for people, but it's especially frightening for your pets. Here are some tips for keeping your four-legged family members snug in a storm.



- 1. Provide a safe space. Find a quiet spot in your home and keep a fluffy blanket there for your pet to snuggle.
- 2. Make sure he has lots of toys. Give your furry friend toys and games to keep him distracted.
- 3. Don't excessively coddle your pet. The over-attention can increase anxiety, so act like nothing is wrong.
- 4. Drown out the noise. Play music or turn the TV on to help distract from the booming thunderclaps.
- 5. Positive reinforcement. Be sure to reward your pet with a treat when he does calm down.
- 6. Consider a ThunderShirt. The snug-fitting shirt is especially designed to calm anxious pets.
- 7. See a vet. If your furry family member has extreme reactions to storms, he may need medication.













Lifestyle

Spring is the time of year for growing flowers, vegetables and herbs. Whether you have a green thumb or are just starting out, these tips will help you grow the garden of your dreams.



1. Write the names of plants on flat stones to create natural garden markers.



2. Fill the bottom of pots with foam peanuts to make them lighter and improve drainage.



3. Grind eggshells into a powder then sprinkle on your plants for a calcium boost.



4. Use plastic forks to keep pets and other animals from destroying your garden.



5. Put diapers in the bottom of your potted pots to help retain moisture.



6. Sprinkle a few tablespoons of Epsom salt onto your plants once a month to maintain a healthy garden.



7. Use leftover vegetable cooking water to fertilize plants.



8. Start your seedlings in a citrus peel to nourish the plants and encourage growth.



9. Grow vegetables in a location that gets at least eight hours of direct sunlight a day.



10. Line flower pots with coffee filters to keep the soil from falling out.



11. Ensure all in-ground plants receive one to two inches of water per week.



12. Pinch the tips of your herbs to encourage new leaf growth.

In Killers of the Flower Moon, David Grann revisits a shocking series of crimes in which dozens of people were murdered in cold blood.
