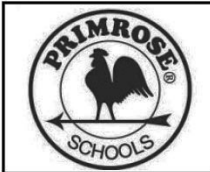

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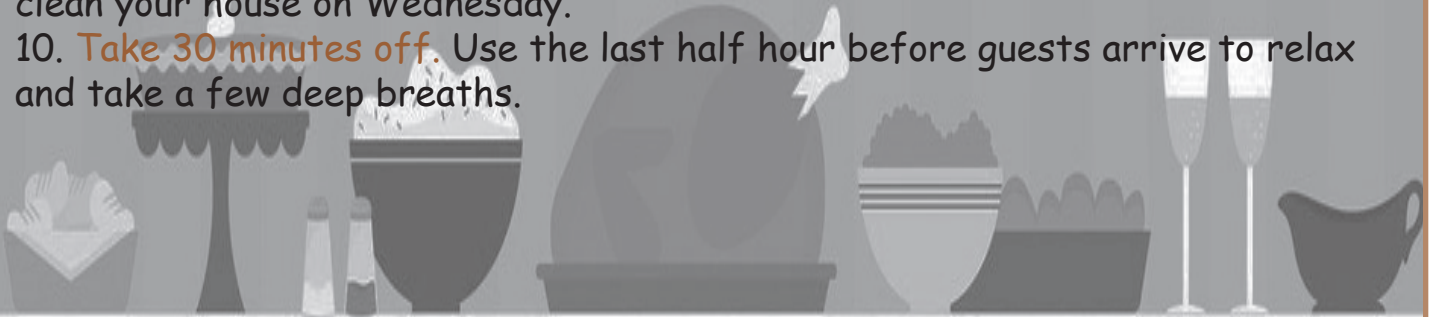
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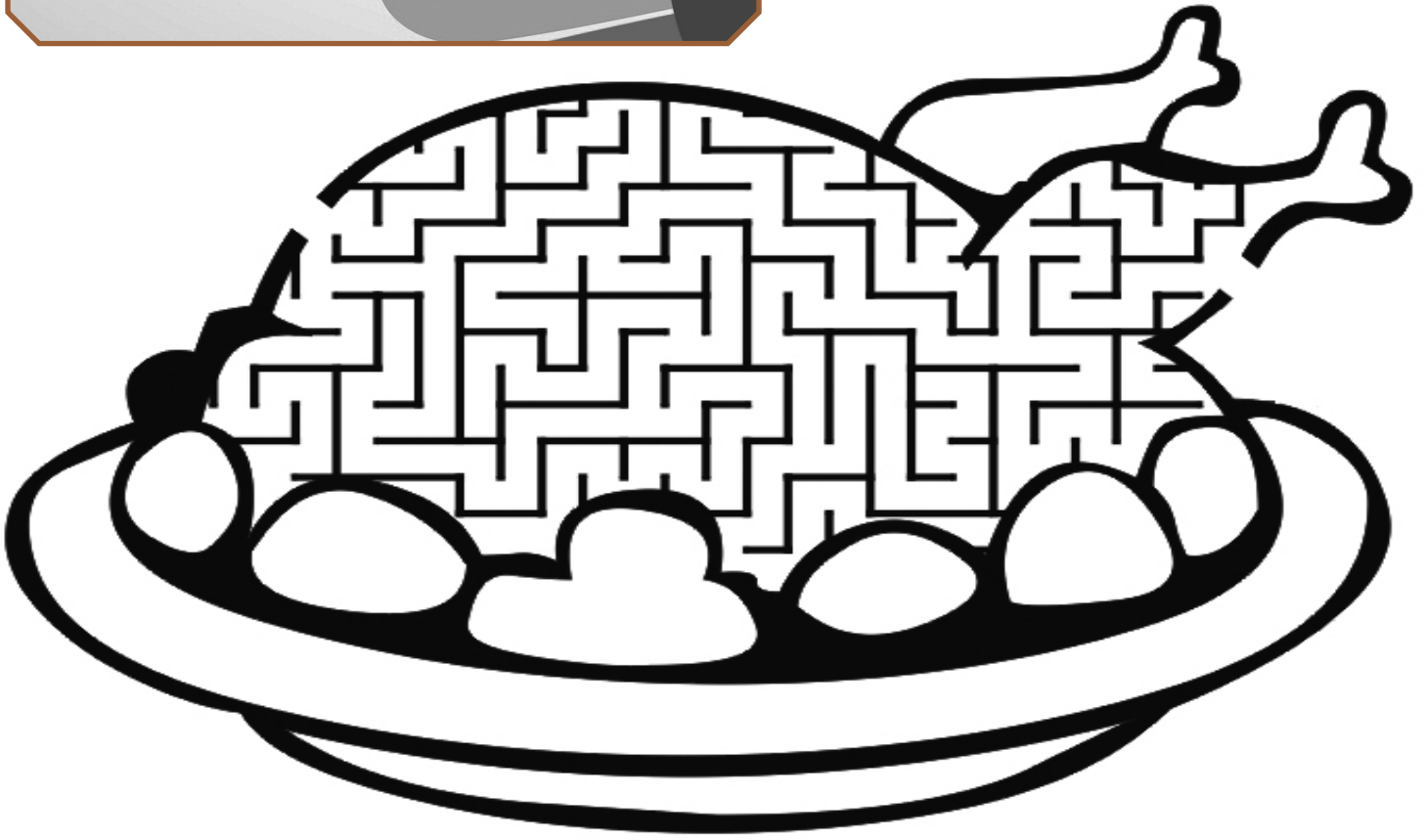
THANKSGIVING *Survival Guide*

Thanksgiving...a time for gathering with family and friends, eating tons of food and watching football. Although it should be a celebration, it can become an overwhelming headache. Here are some tips to keep your cool and plan a stress-free holiday.



1. **Make a menu ahead of time.** Prepare a list of everything you need the weekend prior.
2. **Grocery shop early.** Buy the groceries by Tuesday so you can avoid the crowds and start prep on Wednesday.
3. **Cook in advance.** Most of the sides can be cooked ahead of time, then warmed before the meal.
4. **Buy backups.** Pick up an extra block of cheese, bottle of wine and box of breadcrumbs...just in case.
5. **Keep it simple.** Stick to reliable recipes that you know your family loves. This is not the time to experiment.
6. **Don't do it alone.** Get your kids to help cook, set the table and clean the house.
7. **Maximize your capacity.** Use slow cookers and hot plates when your oven and stovetop are full.
8. **Clean as you go.** Wash cutting boards, knives and bowls after you're finished using them so the dishes don't pile up.
9. **Get the house ready the night before.** Avoid exhaustion on the big day and clean your house on Wednesday.
10. **Take 30 minutes off.** Use the last half hour before guests arrive to relax and take a few deep breaths.

Fall Pet Tips

Fall is the perfect time of year to leave the house and enjoy the outdoors. This is especially true for your four-legged family members. Here are some tips to keep your pet healthy while enjoying fall to the fullest.

1. Watch out for ticks.

Always use tick control and repellent. Also, avoid large piles of leaves as ticks can survive there even in cooler months.

2. Make sure your pet has plenty of food.

When the temperatures drop, your pet needs more energy to stay warm, so a little more food will ensure he has the fuel he needs.

3. Beware of rat poison.

Leftover Halloween candy, cooked Turkey bones, Christmas cookies...these are all hazardous if eaten by your pets.





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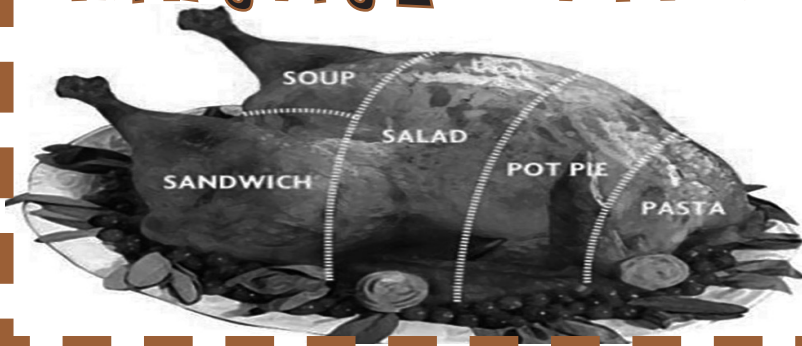

Relaxing with a nice cappuccino, savoring some eggs and bacon and enjoying a cozy café. These are the ingredients to a perfect morning...and what makes Seven Mile Café a hidden gem in Highland Shores.

Seven Mile Café opened in 2013 along 407. The neighborhood café serves breakfast and lunch, with a large selection of vegan options. You'll never leave hungry as the large portions will satisfy even the biggest appetite.

Specializing in breakfast favorites, Seven Mile Café has everything from eggs benedict and huevos rancheros to waffles and biscuits. The Migas are exceptional with jalapenos, chorizo, avocado and cheese. Vegetarians can enjoy the dish with soyrito, instead. And the Loaded Potatoes can't be missed! It's a huge pile of hash browns topped with a variety of vegetables, meat and cheese. Their Chicken Fried Steak and Eggs is a country version of the classic dish.

Light, fluffy and delicious. The made-from-scratch pancakes are incredible! If you have a sweet tooth, try Banana Nutella or Cinnamon Roll. They have gluten-free versions as well as seasonal flavors. If you can't decide...and who can blame you...get the pancake sampler to try three.

The lunch menu is also a delight. Seven Mile Café has several different burgers, including some black bean options. The California Black Bean Burger is scrumptious with grilled onions, red peppers, cheese and avocado. For a twist on a classic, try the Grilled Cheese with Pear. It has loads of gooey cheddar and jack cheese surrounding grilled pears.

Coffee lovers rejoice! Seven Mile Café boasts a delicious selection of French-press coffee. The cappuccinos are a work of art with masterfully crafted designs in the foam. The Nutella Mocha has the perfect balance of nutty espresso and chocolate. My favorite is the NOLA Iced Cold Brew Coffee. It's a heavenly blend with a touch of sweetness.

Seven Mile Café is the perfect place to start your day, or keep you going through the afternoon. And you don't even need to travel seven miles to get there.

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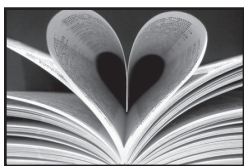


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Book Readers Supper Club

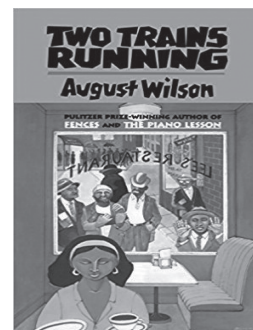
