





Thanksgiving...a time for gathering with family and friends, eating tons of food and watching football. Although it should be a celebration, it can become an overwhelming headache. Here are some tips to keep your cool and plan a stress-free holiday.





- 1. Make a menu ahead of time. Prepare a list of everything you need the weekend prior.
- 2. Grocery shop early. Buy the groceries by Tuesday so you can avoid the crowds and start prep on Wednesday.
- 3. Cook in advance. Most of the sides can be cooked ahead of time, then warmed before the meal.
- 4. Buy backups. Pick up an extra block of cheese, bottle of wine and box of breadcrumbs...just in case.

## Fall Pet Tips

Leftover Halloween candy, cooked Turkey bones, Christmas cookies...these are all hazardous if eaten by your pets.





Specializing in breakfast favorites. Seven Mile Café has everything from eggs benedict and huevos rancheros to waffles






