
BARRACOON

Barracoon: The Story of the Last

Black Cargo Zora Neale Hurston December Gem

A major literary event: a newly published work from the author of the American classic Their Eyes Were Watching God, brilliantly illuminates the horror and injustices of slavery as it tells the true story of one of the last-known survivors of the Atlantic slave trade-abducted from Africa on the last "Black Cargo" ship to arrive in the United States.

In 1927, Zora Neale Hurston went to Plateau, Alabama, just outside Mobile, to interview eighty-six-year-old Cudjo Lewis. Of the millions of men, women, and children transported from



In 1931, Hurston returned to Plateau, the African-centric community three miles from Mobile founded by Cudjo and other former slaves from his ship. Spending more than three months there, she talked in depth with Cudjo about the details of his life. During those weeks, the young writer and the elderly formerly enslaved man ate peaches and watermelon that grew in the backyard and talked about Cudjo's pastmemories from his childhood in Africa, the horrors of being captured and held in a barracoon for selection by American slavers, the harrowing experience of the Middle Passage packed with more than 100 other souls aboard the Clotilda, and the years he spent in slavery until the end of the Civil War.

Based on those interviews, featuring Cudjo's unique vernacular, and written from Hurston's perspective with the compassion and singular style that have made her one of the preeminent American authors of the twentieth-century, Barracoon masterfully illustrates the tragedy of slavery and of one life forever defined by it. Offering insight into the pernicious legacy that continues to haunt us all, black and white, this poignant and powerful work is an invaluable contribution to our shared history and culture.



Book Readers Supper Club

Red Notice, a memoir by Bill Browder, is the December selection for the Highland Shores Readers' Supper Club. Browder, the grandson of Earl Browder who was the Communist party candidate for president in 1936 and 1940, decided late in high school to forego the family tradition and become a capitalist. Such a decision eventually brought him to Russia after the fall of the Soviet Union, where he started a hedge fund, Hermitage Capital Management.



While Browder's sheer determination, financial acumen, and good luck, along with his making the right connections, brought incredible success to Hermitage, eventually such success put him and his firm in the crosshairs of Vladimir Putin and his associates, who perpetrated an elaborate tax refund fraud scheme targeting Hermitage. Putin's Russia proved to be a dangerous place for those seeking to root out corruption, as Browder's tax attorney, Sergei Magnitsky, discovered when he sought redress. As a result of the torture and death of Magnitsky, Browder became a human rights advocate, who was instrumental in the passage of the Magnitsky Act in 2012, which barred those Russians responsible from entering the US.
