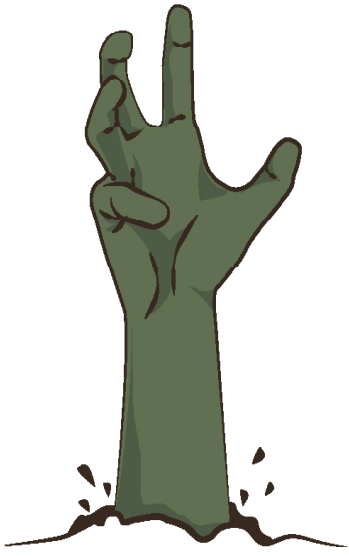

### ***What is your first memory or encounter of Haunted Trail?***

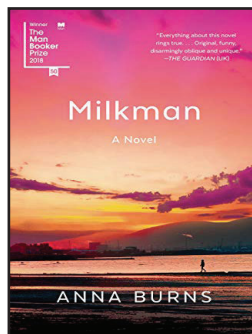

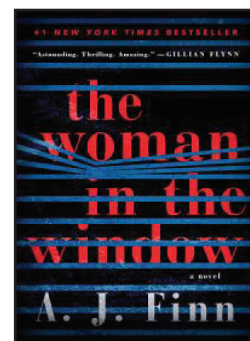
