Introducing your Baby to your Dog

Bringing home a new baby is one of the happiest times in a couple's life, but it can be very confusing for your dog. These tips can help make the transition smoother and create a lifelong bond between your new baby and his or her four-legged sibling.








- 1. Get your dog ready by enrolling him in an obedience class.
- 2. Make gradual changes to your pup's routines so he doesn't associate the changes with the baby.
- 3. Play a recording of baby sounds so your furry friend can become familiar with the new noises.
- 4. Bring an item that has your baby's scent, like a burp cloth, home from the hospital so your dog can learn the new scent.
- 5. Greet your dog alone when you first arrive with the newborn, then slowly introduce him to the baby.
- 6. Keep the baby elevated when interacting with your dog.
- 7. Give your dog extra attention when the baby is around.
- 8. Don't scold your four-legged family member for picking up the baby's toys. Replace the baby toy with a dog toy.

- 10. Keep your dog's crate as a baby-free zone, so he can escape if he needs to.








BOOK CLUB

Of Human Bondage gives a harrowing depiction of unrequited love. Philip Carey, a sensitive orphan born with a clubfoot, finds himself in desperate need of passion and inspiration. He abandons his studies to travel to Paris, where he nurses ambitions of becoming a great artist. Philip's youthful idealism erodes, however, as he comes faceto-face with his own mediocrity. After returning to London to study medicine, he becomes wildly



infatuated with Mildred, a vulgar, tawdry waitress, and begins a doomed love affair that will change the course of his life.

This semi-autobiographical novel combines the values of the Victorian era with the prevailing irony and despair of the early twentieth century. Unsentimental yet bursting with deep feeling, Of Human Bondage remains Maugham's most complete statement of the importance of physical & spiritual liberty.
