Candid Canine Photography Tips

Spring is the perfect time to capture your dog in the beauty of the natural environment. Follow these tips for capturing fantastic shots of your furry friend.



1. Choose a time that your dog is usually in a calm mood. If your dog has a tendency to be hyperactive at a certain time of the day, then avoid it.
2. Make sure your dog feels safe in his or her surroundings. Your dog should be familiar with the equipment you are using to avoid feeling confronted.
3. Use natural light. A flash burst can cause red-eye and frighten them.
4. Go down to their level. This way you stand a better chance of capturing the true personality of your dog.
4. Place a treat right above the camera lens. After you snap a few shots, reward your pup with praise and, of course, the treat!
5. Hold their favorite toy above the camera. If it squeaks, it may trigger some great facial expressions or even an adorable head tilt!

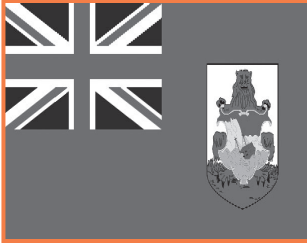

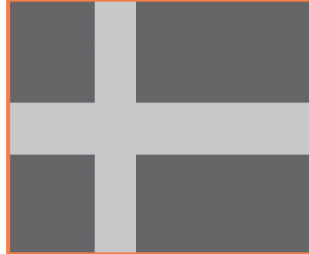
Easter Traditions Around the World

In Bessières, France, thousands eat part of a giant omelette, made with 15,000 fresh eggs.



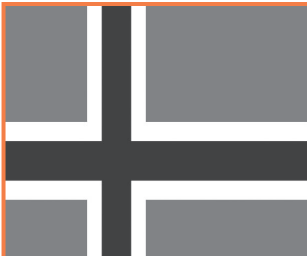
The German tradition of decorating trees and bushes with Easter eggs is known as the Ostereierbaum.



Rara is celebrated in Haiti every year at Easter. This celebration revolves around festival music played during street processions.



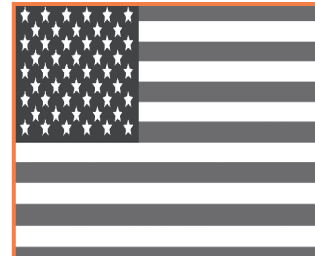
Guatemalans create colorful alfombras, "carpets", made of colored sawdust, flowers, sand, rice, and other mediums.

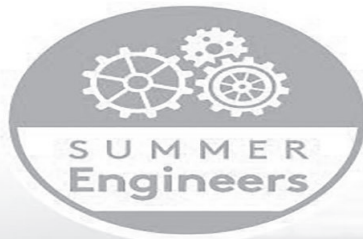

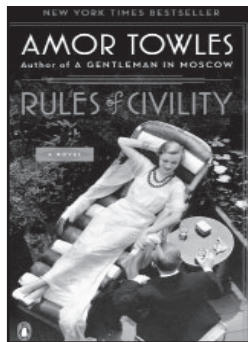

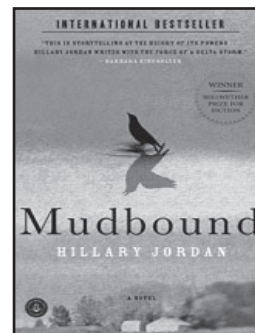

In Jordan's prize-winning debut, prejudice takes many forms, both subtle and brutal. It is 1946, and city-bred Laura McAllan is trying to raise her children on her husband's Mississippi Delta farm—a place she finds foreign and frightening. In the midst of the family's struggles, two young men return from the war to work the land. Jamie McAllan, Laura's brother-in-law, is everything her husband is not—charming, handsome, and haunted by his memories of combat. Ronsel Jackson, eldest son of the black sharecroppers who live on the McAllan farm, has come home with the shine of a war hero. But no matter his bravery in defense of his country, he is still considered less than a man in the Jim Crow South. It is the unlikely friendship of these brothers-in-arms that drives this powerful novel to its inexorable conclusion.

The men and women of each family relate their versions of events and we are drawn into their lives as they become players in a tragedy on the grandest scale. As Kingsolver says of Hillary Jordan, "Her characters walked straight out of 1940s Mississippi and into the part of my brain where sympathy and anger and love reside, leaving my heart racing. They are with me still."
